- **Farm Stock 4000, 5000, 6000, 7000, 9000, 10000,12000**

\$20 entry fee per tractor/per weight class.

Classic class includes tractors **through the year of 1959.**

Farm Stock classes include tractors **of any year.**

Tractor Pull Rules and Regulations

1. Each tractor registered in the pull can pull 1 time per weight class and a maximum of 2 pulls. The maximum number of pulls could be increased during the drivers meeting depending on tractor turnout.
2. Maximum speed limit of **4 mph** for classic classes and **6 mph** for farm stock through 9000 pound class, and **10 mph** for farm stock 10000 and 12000 pound classes.
3. Working governors are required. Governors must maintain no more than **10%** over stock RPM's for classic classes and farm stock classes through 9000 pounds. Maximum RPM of **3000** in the farm stock 10000 and 12000 classes. Officials will test governors if necessary. Officials will make the final decision.
4. All tractors must be weighed first at lowest weight class pulling in that evening and immediately before they pull. There is no over weight allowance. 4000 means a maximum of 4000.
5. Drawbars must be standard height from ground (20 inches or less), and a minimum of 18 inches from center of axle to hook up.
6. Driver needs to provide a twisted-style clevis or pull hitch with a 3" opening in the hole. Hook chain must not touch any other part of tractor. No hooking over a drawbar.
7. Kill switches (brake away switches) are suggested.
8. Side panels on any tractors in the pull must be available to be opened.
9. Any tractor manufactured with a torque converter (i.e., TA on a Farmall) is allowed to use the torque converter once per hook in the classic classes. There is no restriction on the farm stock classes.
10. No tractors with **Cut Tires, Duals, or 4-wheel drive** allowed. Maximum tire size for farm stock 10000 and 12000 classes is **20.8 x 38. Turbos** allowed only in the farm stock 10000 and 12000 pound classes.
11. When hooking up to the sled, tractor must be in **neutral** and the **driver's foot must be off the clutch.**
12. All drivers must stay on tractor seat during their pull.
13. One restart will be allowed per pull. (Has to be less than 75 feet.)
14. Any piece, part or weight that falls off of tractor during its pull will result in immediate disqualification.
15. Drivers must be 18 years of age or parental approval is required.
16. **No drinking of alcohol** before or during the pull or drivers will be disqualified.
17. All drivers must attend the driver's safety meeting that will be held before the tractor pull starts.
18. **NO REFUND** of registration fee if Puller is disqualified.
19. Un-sportsman like conduct will not be tolerated.
20. **All judges decisions are FINAL.**
